**BEST OF BREED**

**BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY:** All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

**NON-REGULAR CLASS (involving Single Dog Entries)**

**VETERAN** - A class for dogs and a class for bitches seven years of age or older. The winners of these classes will be eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition.

**EARTHDOG** - A class for dogs that are titled Earthdog Dogs and a class for bitches that are titled Earthdog Bitches.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES (involving Multiple Dog Entries)**

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**STUD DOG** – For Stud Dogs and at least two, but not more than four, of their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog does not need to be the owner of the Get. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its Get. The Get must be entered in a Regular Class or a Non-Regular Class other than Stud Dog. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee in addition to any entry fees for other classes in which he is entered. There is no additional fee for the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

**BROOD BITCH** – Same as for the Stud Dog Class, substituting Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**BRACE** – Two dogs of the same breed or variety that are similar in appearance, perform in unison and have at least one common owner. They must be presented in other classes by a maximum of two handlers.

**SWEEPSTAKES  
REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION**

The Scottish Terrier Club of America Sweepstakes is open to all Scottish Terriers between the ages of 6 months and 18 months. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class." No professional handler will be allowed to show a dog in Sweepstakes unless the dog is owned by the professional handler, a member of the immediate family or bred by the handler.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Puppy, 6 Months & Under 9 Months
  - Junior, 9 Months & Under 12 Months
  - Senior, 12 Months & Under 18 Months
- For each division (Puppy, Junior and Senior), the Dogs and Bitches will be judged separately.

**Order of Judging**

Puppy Dogs, 6 months to 9 months, will be judged, followed by Puppy Bitches, 6 months to 9 months. The First and Second Place Dogs and First and Second Place Bitches will then compete for the four placements in the Age Division Run-Off Stakes. Junior Dogs, 9 months to 12 months, will then be judged, followed by Junior Bitches, 9 months to 12 months. The First and Second Place Dogs and the First and Second Place Bitches will then compete for the four placements in the Age Division Run-Off Stakes. Senior Dogs, 12 months to 18 months, and Senior Bitches, 12 months to 18 months, will then be judged in the same order and the same manner. First Place in each AGE DIVISION RUN-OFF STAKES will then compete for BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES.

After \$5.00 is withheld for expenses,

the entry fee money for each class will be divided as follows:

50% to the Class Winners; 50% to the Age Division Run-Off Stakes Winners

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Austin Ballroom will be available to exhibitors after 3:00 PM Friday, April 16, 2010. The club reserves the right to alter this time depending on the condition of the building. Set-up will be supervised by members of the club or their representatives. All dogs must be removed from the Ballroom by one hour following Best in Specialty on Sunday, April 18, 2010.

### General

Exhibitors are expected to comply with all club rules as laid out and enforced by STCGH. SOLID WASTE MUST BE PICKED UP AND DISPOSED OF IN APPROPRIATE CONTAINERS PROVIDED BY THE HOST CLUB. Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees, other permanent fixtures or left unattended in vehicles. All judging will be in the Austin Ballroom. The Show Secretary, STCA, STCGH or the City of Houston will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the results of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is in the building or on the grounds of the Crown Plaza Hotel.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when exercising.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the show secretary advised at once. The show secretary and the show giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

### Grooming and Crating

Please note: The grooming area in the Austin Ballroom will be closed to additional crates, equipment, etc., when the Show Committee determines the area is FULL. Should the grooming area in the Ballroom be closed due to capacity being reached, there will be additional grooming and crating across the hall from the ballroom.

NO PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BALLROOM. Dogs must be exercised in designated areas outside the buildings.

### Parking Regulations

There is limited RV parking behind the Hotel in their parking lot. RV's must be self-contained. There are no hookups and there is not a dump station. Positively no dumping of drain or holding tanks. No filling of water tanks from any source. All parking will be on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis. Spaces may not be saved.

The Show Committee reserved the right to enter or authorize entrance to a vehicle using whatever means necessary to rescue dogs in distress. All persons attending this dog show waive any claim for damages against the show giving club for such removal.

### Notice

**Errors on entry blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms and no refunds or cancellation will be made in the event of such errors.

All prizes, ribbons, trophies, etc must be claimed during the show hours. Otherwise, they shall become the property of the show giving club. The show giving clubs reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

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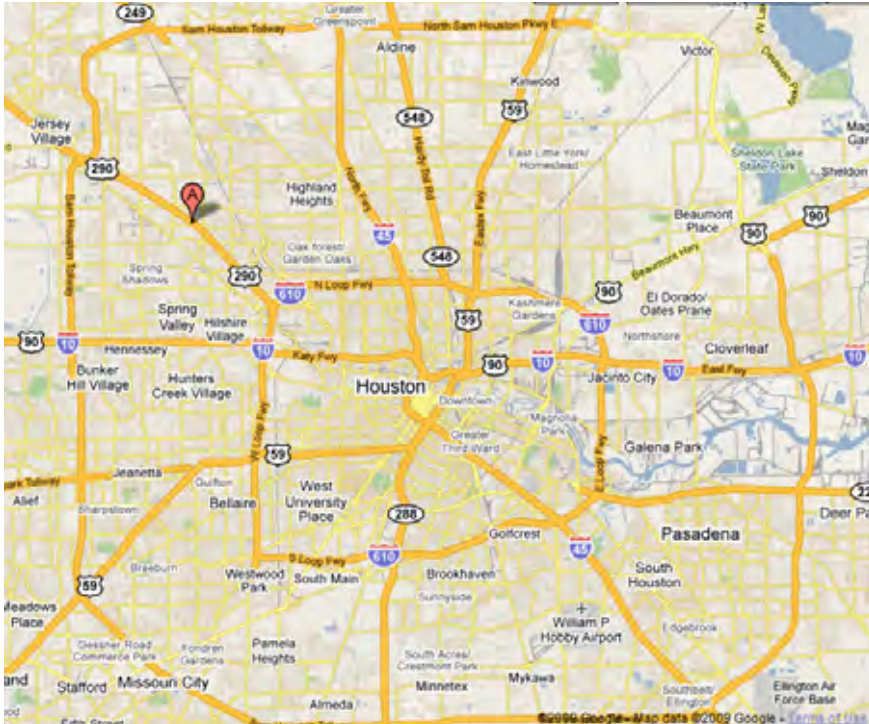
